Position and Description	Name of Nominee
<b>Vice Chair</b> The Vice-Chair must be affiliated with a non-profit direct service provider member organization. The Vice-Chair shall assist the Chair in the performance of his duties and shall assume such other duties as are assigned by the Chair and approved by the Board. The Vice-Chair shall have responsibility for and maintenance of the Administrative Code. In the absence of the Chair, the Vice-Chair shall assume the duties of the Chair, and shall preside at the meetings of the Corporation, of the Board and of the Executive Committee. In the event that the Chair shall be unable to serve, the Vice-Chair shall succeed to the office of the Chair for the remainder of the Chair's term. Upon the end of the Chair's term and confirmation by the majority of the voting membership the Vice-Chair will hold the position of Chair for the next term.	
<b>Secretary</b> The secretary shall be elected from the members in good standing. The secretary shall keep an accurate record of the proceedings of all meetings of the Corporation, of the Board, and of the Executive Committee.	
<b>Indirect Service Provider</b> A member at large that represents the indirect service provider.	
<b>Representative of Historically Underserved</b> A member at large that represents the historically underserved populations of Sexual Assault and Family Violence
