## Inetnon Yo'åmte Hatdin Hinemlo (Healing Garden) Community Planting & Outreach

The Guam Coalition Against Sexual Assault & Family Violence (GCASAFV) will host its *'Planting & Walking' Phase 2* of its Inetnon Yo'åmte Project at its Hatdin Hinemlo, the Healing Garden. The event will take place on Saturday, February 10, 2024, from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., located at the Medical Arts Center in Dededo, adjacent to the Guam Regional Medical City in Dededo.

Various community agencies will be present to provide information about the services they offer. Volunteers will assist with Phase 2 of the project to plant more trees and shrubs and create wellness pathways throughout the property. The goal of Hatdin Hinemlo (healing garden) is to promote health and wellness, while fostering environmental stewardship.
